6. Memory devices

Look for ways to organize the material you are learning. Use memory devices. For example, visualize the word when you study it, if you are studying the verb "nadar" you may want to visualize someone swimming every time you study that word. Find memory devices that work for you.

7. Organize

Keep all of your Spanish materials in one folder or binder. You will receive many handouts and worksheets. The easier it is for you to find your materials the more time you will have to spend studying. DO NOT throw away your quizzes, since they will be helpful to you in studying for the unit tests.

8. Come in for help before it is to late

If you are feeling lost come in immediately for help. It is better to come in right away when you start feeling lost, rather than waiting until it is to late, after we have taken the quiz or test.
