

## PITFALL

### ARTÍCULOS DEFINIDOS

The masculine article *el* must be used with singular feminine nouns beginning with a stressed *a* or *ha*. (This makes the combination easier to pronounce). In the plural, however, the same nouns take the normal feminine *las*. (The *s* separates the *a*'s).

*el agua*    the water  
*el águila*    the eagle  
*el hacha*    the ax

BUT

*las aguas*    the waters  
*las águilas*    the eagles  
*las hachas*    the axes

## PITFALL # 8

### **SUSTANTIVOS**

Some nouns have masculine and feminine forms with *different* meanings. These words should be used with special attention to correct gender in order to avoid being misunderstood.

*el pez* - fish  
*la pez* - pitch, tar

*el guía* - guide (person)  
*la guía* - guide (handbook)

*el tema* - theme, topic  
*la tema* - fixed idea, mania

*el cometa* - comet  
*la cometa* - kite

*el coma* - coma  
*la coma* - comma

*el pendiente* - earring  
*la pendiente* - slope

*el policía* - policeman  
*la policía* - police (force)
