SHOP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Safe Conduct and Dress. I AGREE TO:

- Purchase school insurance or bring a note signed by my parent(s) verifying that I have suitable personal accident and medical insurance.
- 2. Inform my teacher of any allergies or handicaps before using the shop.
- 3. Occupy my assigned place at the beginning of the period.
- 4. Wear safety glasses at all times when in the shop, use special goggles as needed for handling chemicals and caustic materials, and wear shields or helmet when conducting hazardous operations.
- 5. Wear prescribed protective clothing and not wear long neckties, loose sleeves, or other loose clothing.
- 6. Practice general cleanliness and orderliness at all times.
- 7. Not wear finger rings when handling molten metal or working on electrical systems.
- 8. Not loiter in the shop.
- 9. Not throw objects in the shop.
- 10. Avoid "horseplay" at all times in the shop.
- 11. Report all accidents including minor cuts, scratches, and splinters to the instructor promptly.
- 12. Remain in the shop or classroom at all times except when excused by the instructor.
- 13. Help with shop cleanup and storage duties until the job is finished.

Safe Machine Use, I AGREE TO:

- 1. Never operate power equipment unless specifically authorized.
- 2. Never operate machines unless the guards are in place.
- 3. Use all tools for the purpose intended and in the approved manner as taught by the instructor.
- 4. Stand to the side of grinding wheels, buffers, and blades while the machine is gaining speed, and out of the fire path when furnaces and other burners are being started.
- 5. Remove keys from chucks when adjustments are complete.
- 6. Fasten all work securely before drilling, milling, sanding, and other such operations.
- 7. Avoid talking to or otherwise distracting others using machines or doing hazardous activities.
- 8. Not leave machines unattended, nor repair, oil, clean, or adjust them while they are running.
- 9. Not force machines beyond the capacity for which they were designed.
- 10. Report to the teacher all electrical equipment that is not properly grounded or otherwise safe to use.
- 11. Report to the teacher all tools and machinery in need of repair, and any hazards that I observe.

Safe Materials Handling. I AGREE TO:

- 1. Obtain the teacher's permission and read the label before using any pesticides or other chemicals.
- 2. Handle, use and store pesticides and other chemicals properly.
- 3. Not use gasoline as a cleaner or solvent, and to handle all fuels in the prescribed ways.
- Not permit water to be poured into acid or molten metal, nor permit grease or oil to come into contact with molten metal.
- 5. Handle and store all soiled materials, rags, paints, solvents, and flammable materials in the approved manner.
- 6. Lift or move heavy objects in the approved manner only.

I have read the above rules and discussed them in class with my instructor. I realize they are for my protection and I will do all I can to see that they are enforced. I will observe all precautions given by my instructor or others assigned to supervise my participation in school and school-related activities.
