If You are Driven to/from School....



- Arrive <u>after</u> 7:40 a.m. That is when staff supervision is available.
- Use the loop drive in the front of the school for drop off/pick up. Stop next to the curb to get out of/in your vehicle, so you won't cross in front of traffic. Vehicles should not be parked in this loop. Adults should park in the front lot if they need to enter the building or wait with their child.
- Adults may park on Hanneman Blvd. or Lincoln St.
- Do not park in the lot near our gym and playground.
- Please follow all posted signs.

We need the cooperation of ALL parents and students to make this Traffic Safety Plan work.

If You Ride the Bus to/from School....



- You will enter/exit the bus in the bus parking lot on Garfield St.
- Only buses will be allowed in the bus parking area.

 Follow all bus rules for your continued ability to ride.

If You Bike/Skateboard to/from School....



- Arrive <u>after</u> 7:40 a.m. That is when staff supervision is available.
- Always wear your helmet.
- Walk your bike/skateboard in a crosswalk when crossing the street.
- Walk your bike/skateboard on school grounds and sidewalks.
- Park and lock your bike in the bicycle rack on Garfield St.
- Store skateboards in classrooms.

If You Walk to/from School....



- Arrive <u>after</u> 7:40 a.m. That is when staff supervision is available.
- Always use the crosswalks to cross streets.
- DO NOT cross in the middle of the street. After school crossing guards are located at:
 - > Hanneman Blvd. & Lincoln St.

- > Hanneman Blvd. & Garfield St.
- Eighth St. & Garfield St. (also before school)

Attention All Parents and Students

Please observe and follow all street signs and all traffic, parking and pedestrian laws.

The Mount Horeb Police Dept. will ticket anyone who breaks these laws while dropping off or picking up a child(ren).

Drivers must yield the right of way to pedestrians crossing the street at a marked crosswalk
