

## 2025 WGCF - Madison District Scholarship Information

## Dear Candidate:

The Wisconsin Garden Club Federation (WGCF) is the largest volunteer gardening organization in Wisconsin. It is a non-profit organization, founded in 1928, to stimulate the knowledge of gardening, the protection of trees, wildflowers, birds, and natural areas, and to promote civic beautification.

The purpose of this scholarship is to advance a graduating high school student's pursuit toward a degree in a horticulture-related field of study such as landscape design, botany, conservation, forestry, or environmental studies. Academic proficiency and an active extra-curricular record are advantageous.

The completed scholarship application form plus <u>three</u> recommendation forms are required – two from educators who are familiar with your academic achievement; the other from an adult of your choice.

Attach an essay (no more than one page) entitled "A Growing Interest" discussing the basis for your choice of study.

An official copy of your academic transcript is to be sent separately **by the high school guidance counselor** to the Scholarship Committee by the application deadline. Please make sure they have sent it to me.

\$1,000.00 and a possible additional contribution from individuals will be awarded to the recipient based on the application and review of the aforementioned criteria and the successful completion of their first semester of college, as evidenced by our receipt of an official college transcript, a copy of the registration for next semester, AND a letter by the student explaining how the semester went.

All the required application items are to be <u>postmarked no later than</u> **Tuesday**, **April 1**, **2025** to me, Chair of the Scholarship Committee.
