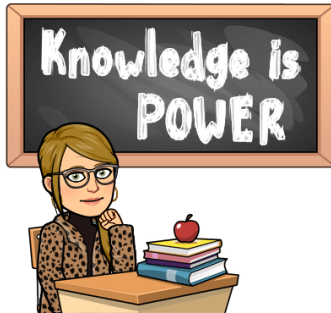

Friday Folders

Assignment Notebooks

Thank you to all of you for signing the assignment notebook page each night. It is a great tool for communication. We usually fill them out first thing in the morning, so I do see the messages.

Academics:

Reading- We are working on building up our "muscle memory" when it comes to reading to self. We also learned about picking "Just Right" books. Those are books that your child could read most of the words on each page (may need help with 1 or 2), and they can understand what they are reading.

Math- Please look for an overview of Unit 1 in your child's Friday folder today. In this unit we are focusing on addition and subtraction strategies. I will be sending home sheets on "Helping at Home". Just know there are many ways to get to an answer. As we practice them, your child will find ones that work for them. *Please note, if your child is really struggling on a homework assignment, jot me a note and send along with their homework. I will help them in school.*

Language arts- This week and next we will be taking a few assessments. Today we finished a spelling screener testing the students on their priority word. Next week we will be spending 45 minutes writing about a small moment in their life. Both of these will help me learn more about your child as a learner and what skills they know and what skills they will need to work on.

Social studies/Science- We opened the wall for the first time so Mrs. Messmann and I could introduce ourselves and share with the students the topics they will be learning in both social studies and science. The students were excited to see friends in the other room.

In the next few weeks the students will be taking a district assessment for both math and reading. These are both small snapshots to see where the children are at this time. There is also a fluency portion where I will be able to sit one on one with the students and listen to them read.
