Academics:

Reading/language arts- We have started Unit 4: The Ancient Roman Civilization. We learned what Rome used to look like compared to what it looks like now. Then we learned the legend of brothers Romulus and Remus, who were believed to have started Rome. We also learned about the gods and goddesses of Rome/Greece and the powers they possessed. Next came the Punic battles telling how Rome finally conquered the Carthaginians after over a hundred years. Now we're beginning to learn what daily life was like in Rome over 2000 years ago.


Ask your child to tell you a few things they have been learning about Rome. There is too much information for me to list, but you could ask them to tell you about a battle, name a god or goddess, tell about life there, ect.

Spelling- It is so important that you find time to study the spelling words/rules. We write it every night in the assignment notebooks. Even if you just practice a few words each night, it would be beneficial. The last set of words were tricky because not only did the kids need to know how to spell them, they had to put them in the correct category. Our next set of words should be coming home today in your child's homework folder. Please keep them in a safe place to practice.

This next set of words all have the long e sound; we are learning about two different patterns:

<u>vowel team of ee</u>	&	<u>e in open syllable words</u>
Sleep		Venus - (Ve nus)
Degree		create- (cre ate)

Math- Unit 4 is all about measurement. Our goal at the end of the unit is to be able to know the difference between the 3 types of measurements and what units we'd use to measure them - length/centimeters or meters, mass/ grams or kilograms, liquid volume/ milliliters or liters. Another goal is to solve multi step story problems efficiently. We have been practicing using CUBES to help us figure out what to do. We actually use the word equation for the E. Write an equation to know what to do 1st.



Number Corner- This week we took our Number Corner assessment. It covered everything from multiplication timed tests, fractions, elapsed time, and many story problems- single step and multiple step.
