Mrs. Moore's Class

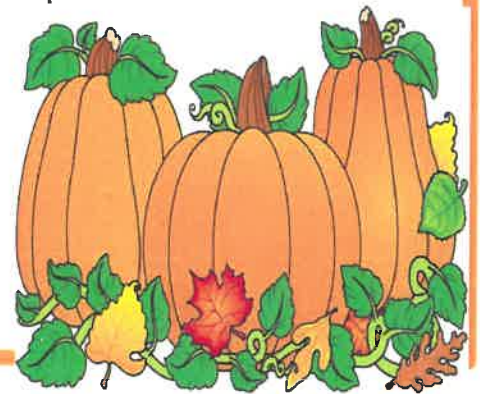
We have been learning about pets this week. We have read books and sang songs about pets. We shared if we had a pet or if we could have one what it would be.
