



## WHAT'S NEW?

In the addition, the second floor classrooms are receiving final finishes. Ceiling tiles have been placed, and flooring has been installed. On the first floor, cabinetry is being installed in labs and classrooms. Painting is ongoing, and project engineers are finishing up work on the electrical/HVAC/plumbing systems. Outside the academic addition, the greenhouse has been completed. The courtyards are taking shape as the construction team starts work on concrete sidewalks. Seat walls have also been installed in the exterior commons, outside of the cafeteria.

We remain on time and under budget. That has given the Board pause to consider what/how many additional projects can be considered using the earned savings and within the framework of the community's April 2017 authorized borrow. Very soon, the administrative team, with the assistance of Bray Architects, will recommend additional work based on the District's Long Range Facility Plan. Once this proposal is offered (June 17, 2019, Board meeting), it is essential that we receive the community's feedback. We hope you will please consider attending this meeting to share your perspective. We anticipate the vast majority of any new work would be completed in the summer of 2020.
